Old Business:

John Lackey followed-up with his last month's announcement & request for the Car Show raffle funds to be donated towards the new City/Union County Sign project \$16,000 per sign– need \$3,000 more to finish first sign. Next year they propose one from the West side going east on I84. Signs will be on city/county owned land so no rent for the land. The sign committee would also like a sign on the corner of Hunter & Hwy 82 where the old Bronson Truss Manufacturing lot is – this lot is owned by the city so the only expense would be the purchase & maintenance of the sign, no rent for the land. Signs are metal and are solar-lit. We usually get \$800 from the raffle which goes in part to the Shriners Hospital. Stan Terry reported that Island City has contributed.

Dixie & Ed, since they do the raffle – only concern was that the raffle items come from local businesses, are these businesses been approached already by the sign project? Would the donors still see the benefit – balance between the emotion and monetary appeal.

All Chamber members received a letter from the sign committee asking for donations – we should not lose any prize donation because of this – Rick Gately confirmed this. Since the local businesses would actually benefit from the signs, there should not be a problem. This would be a one-year time donation from the club to the sign project for this year.

Motion: John – motion to donate ½ to each the sign project and to the Shriners – Jack 2nd – all in favor.
