Call to Order

Minutes

Motion: Arlan moved to approve the February minutes. Mary Ann seconded and the motion passed.

Treasurer's Report

- Virginia reported that we have a balance of \$5,925.06. She added that she has not received all of the membership dues yet, and that she has received checks from two of our sponsors.

Old Business

- Tana brought some T-shirts as samples of what the fabric will be like and pictures of the color choices. The darker blue is the current favorite.
- Arlan commented on the addition of several new classifications of cars and trucks that are listed on the car show registration form. These have been added to more accurately represent the entries.
- It was reported that 5-6 people showed up to stuff envelopes last week. It took about an hour and 190 flyers and registration forms were mailed. Arlan said that forms were not sent to car clubs this year as the addresses are usually inaccurate.

New Business

- John reported that the club's liability insurance with Hartford expires April 15th. The cost to renew this plan for another year would increase from \$540 to \$848. He obtained a proposal from Valley Insurance for the same coverage we've had only for a 3-day event (which would cover the car show). The cost for that policy would be \$283.74.

Motion: Mary Ann moved that we purchase the 3-day event policy from Valley Insurance. Deb seconded and the motion passed.

- Mary Ann and Margarete will work together to choose activities for the Club this summer. It was decided that we would have an activity every other Friday instead of every Friday. Events will begin in late May.
- Arlan noted that car club pictures have been submitted to CruZin' Magazine and that they will be in the next issue. We will be receiving an invoice.
- Mary Ann reported that Frank Carlson has agreed to sing for the car show in August. Additional speakers will be provided by Brent Clapp.

Other

- Jim asked if there could be a car parts yard sale/swap meet at the Elgin car show. Steve said that there is a place to set that up and it is fine with him. They will add that to the flyer for the car show.
