### **Call to Order**

President, Richard Comstock, called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. He introduced our new members, Mat and Toni Miles. Welcome!!!

### **Minutes**

Virginia moved and Paula seconded that the minutes be approved as sent. The motion passed.

### **Financial Report**

Treasurer, Paula Fong, reported the club has a bank balance of \$4759.17.

### **Old Business**

Richard shared that he, Paula and Virginia completed paperwork at the bank to change signees on our account from Virginia and Mary Ann to him and Paula. Paula added that it was a bit of an ordeal. It was suggested that maybe we should change banks, but Virginia said it is quite complicated to do that.

Richard restated that for our twice monthly summer burger cruises, we need to consider having some on nights other than Friday. He also said that we need someone to arrange those. Jim and Sally will do that. He said that perhaps rising gas prices would discourage members from participating, and Ed suggested that we just keep them local.

**Tri-Cities Meeting** Arlan, Don and Steve attended the regional car club meeting in Tri-Cities. Arlan reported that they met people from many local clubs. Don won a T-shirt and free resgitation to a Tri-Cities car show. Car show insurance was one of the discussion items. John explained that our club just has liability insurance for the car show so if someone gets injured, the insurance will pay. Arlan added that it is car owners' responsibility if something happens to their cars. A discussion followed with John explaining different types of coverage.

## **New Business**

Jim Coxen asked if members would be interested in having button-up shirts with the club logo embroird on the back to be worn as advertisement for the club. He suggested that they also have the member's first name on the pocket. Jim will pursue that.

**Car show:** Arlan passed around car show booklets which have our car show listed. He confirmed that the car show will be on July 15, 16 and 17. He passed around the sign-up sheet again for members to volunteer to work at the show.

Arlan also reiterated that members' cars are all parked together by Goss Motors and are not eligible for awards except for the favorite member car award. Members who participate will also receive free dinners on Friday and Saturday.

Jerry Matthews said we need to have a white board with raffle ticket numbers somewhere at the other end of the street in addition to the one across from Goss' so that people don't have to walk so far to check ticket numbers. There was discussion on how that would work and agreed that we can probably do it. Jerry also said it would be nice if there was some identifying number on the cars entered in the show to indicate which class they are registered in. Arlan will work on that.

Arlan announced that there is a car show in Heppner this Saturday, the 12<sup>th</sup> and one at Riverside Park on March 20<sup>th</sup> sponsored by the Eastern Oregon Car Club.

Arlan also shared that we have a letter from the 4H radio auction asking for a free registration for our car show for their auction. John made a motion for the club to donate that, Ed seconded and the motion passed.

Arlan asked for volunteers to stuff envelopes at the Chamber of Commerce on Thursday at 9:00. Several volunteered.

Loyd asked if Goss' 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration was part of our car show, and Arlan explained that it was separate, but Goss has donated all the bags that will be given to car show registrants.

Tana shared that our T-shirts this year will be black. They are a tri blend that holds up well. They have Goss 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary on the front and sponsors on the back. They are \$14.00 and she will order 100. She has a few shirts from last year that she will also sell at the car show. She is also asked if she needs to order more "Staff" shirts for club members to wear at the car show.

Richard told the group that the Baker and Enterprise car shows are on the same date this year, August 20<sup>th</sup>.

Arlan said that on August 27<sup>th</sup> there will be a music festival and semi truck show in Union, and John Schneider of Dukes of Hazzard and his car will be there. They have invited our club to come.

Jim Coxen asked if any of our local hotels sponsor the car show. Arlan responded that he has talked to them in the past, and they are not interested.

Dixie told the club that Carol Campbell's high school class is having their 60<sup>th</sup> class reunion on fair weekend and would like to have the club's cars in the fair parade to carry class members. The fair will be on the first complete weekend in August.

Arlan encouraged members to enter their cars in the show at Riverside Park on March 20<sup>th</sup>.
