## Car Show

Mary Ann asked the club to consider purchasing new tables for the July car show as ours are old, heavy and pinch fingers.

**Motion:** A motion was made by Jim Coxen, seconded by John Lackey.

**Result:** The motion was passed.

### 2. Shirts for the \$20.00 each with the sky blue color to remain

Margaret Craig asked for input regarding the car show dinner and possibilities of providers: Chef Merlyn, Hines Meat Co., Lyons Club, Island City Market and Cock N Bull. Club to revisit this topic and decide on a provider considering meals and cost.

Arlan announced we should have car show sponsorship equal to what we had last year with the only change John Howard Realty (John Retired) and the Company name is now High Country Realty.

Tana McClay introduced a T-shirt idea for the club with a photo of the old historic Perkins Ford Dealer building in the background with a classic Ford pickup in the foreground. The cost of the shirts will be \$20.00 and if agreed on, Tana wanted to know if the club liked the picture with or without the background blue sky color.

**Motion:** A motion was made by Jim Coxen, seconded by Mel Towne.

**Result:** The motion was passed.

### 3. Car Show Budget

Mary Ann presented the car show budget to Don McLean and asked if the club would like a copy and approve it or if the car show committee could review it and offer approval.

**Motion:** No vote.

Don turned the mic over to Jim Coxen and before he could say much, the club membership voted unanimously cheering “Aye” for Jim to be the Chairman. Jim went on to explain what his plans for this year would be and how he would communicate with everyone. Jim asked members to give suggestions for “Burger Cruises” and other ideas. All cruises are always weather permitting. Jim will advise each month and announce at meetings events coming up.

### Technical Corner
